Multiplication

<p>Pull out 20 fact cards and sort them into 2 piles: Even Products and Odd Products</p>	<p>Pull out 10 fact cards. Put their products in order from smallest to largest.</p>	<p>Choose a fact card and write a story problem to match it. Draw a picture to match the story. <i>For example:</i> 5×2 <i>There were 5 children. Each child had 2 balloons. How many balloons were there in all?</i></p>
<p>Pull 2 fact cards. Write a comparison sentence using the two facts. Repeat 5 times. <i>For example: $3 \times 5 > 4 \times 3$</i></p>	<p>Pull out 10 fact cards and draw an array to represent the fact. <i>For example:</i> <i>An array for 3×4 looks like</i></p>  <p>• • • • • • • • • • • •</p>	<p>Pull out 10 fact cards and draw a picture to represent the product. <i>For example:</i> 3×5 is 3 groups of 5</p>
